Background: This scholarship is a wonderful and unexpected gift from Lars J. Spinner, a local resident who lived on Woodmancy Road in Randolph.

Growing up on a farm near Malone, NY, not far from the Canadian border, Mr. Spinner worked hard to put himself through college. It was his determination and work ethic that led him to earn a bachelor's degree in mechanical engineering from the Indiana Institute of Technology and a master's degree from SUNY Potsdam.

A veteran of the United States Army, Mr. Spinner served as a special agent to the Central Intelligence Agency. Following his service, he accepted a position as a senior consulting engineer at Xerox, Inc. in Rochester, and worked there until his retirement in 1998.

Mr. Spinner was a brilliant engineer who enjoyed reading and studying ancient history, including archaeology, and was fascinated by the building of the pyramids. It was his desire to instill in students the importance of an education and to offer Randolph students the opportunity to financially support them on this journey toward higher education.
